THE Cairns Taipans are today expected to announce they have parted ways with coach Aaron Fearne following the 2017-18 NBL season.

Multiple sources have confirmed to the *Cairns Post* the club will today make the announcement official, ending his tenure at the Far North Queensland team at nine seasons.

Fearne, who started with the club as a player, took the Taipans to two grand final series' but in his last three year contract has failed to win a finals game and missed the finals in the 2017-18 season.

The Taipans finished sixth on the NBL ladder this season with an 11-17 record.

Fearne took over the Taipans coaching job following the 2008-09 season, after Alan Black left the club during the season.

Speaking on Wednesday night at the club's awards night, Cairns Taipans CEO Mark Beecroft offered "a huge thank you" to the club's coaching staff but failed to shed any light on the future of his out-of contract coach.

"This year was a real challenge.

"Managing the ins-and-outs with the roster and all the curveballs, I think you did an incredible job.

"The fact that you can go into Perth (and win) in the second last game I think is a credit to the team and showed the potential of what a healthy roster could have looked like this year.

"I want to congratulate the guys on what they achieved and sticking it through right till the end."

The Taipans will now turn to finding a new head coach, the first time they have had to do so in a decade, as well as looking to retain star guards Cameron Gliddon and Mitch McCarron, who are out of contract.

"Whether or not I stay or go, that will be decided in the next few months," Gliddon told 7 News on Friday.

"That is a huge process ... and from there we will see what direction the club goes in and where they want to go."

Fearne said on a number of different occasions through the recent season that 2017-18 had been his toughest since he took the top job, dealing with several injuries and imports coming in and out of the squad.

"I'm just trying to get through this season and see where things go from there. It's not up to me (if I stay)," he said in late January.

"I've been here a long time, had some good success.

"Ultimately, at the end of the day I'd like to win a championship for this club and so would the players.

"I'd like to do it for the city and the fans. We've been close but it's really hard to win a championship in any single sport.

"It's really, really hard. We've done some good things. It'd nice to take that next step."
